

Frederick Biehle fbiehle@pratt.edu The Pratt Institute School of Architecture offers an advanced undergraduate program for the 4th year students to study architecture and Italian culture in Rome. The encounter with the city, a place foreign and yet familiar, profound and contradictory, is intended to site a reconsideration of design priorities. The investigation of the remains of antiquity and Rome's urban artifacts can offer a unique lesson; the interaction of physical cause and cultural effect on the built environment and its cumulative presence through time.

Design studio is the backbone of the semester in Copenhagen. You will choose between the interior Architecture studio and Urban Design studio. Students from Architecture, Interior Architecture and Urban Design studios are brought together in elective courses, field studies and study tours. Enrollment will be limited to 12 qualifying students based on review of the applicant's portfolio and academic transcript. If necessary, a portfolio interview will take place by appointment, and a waiting list will be created.


